Water Bottles

I would like to clarify any confusion and/or mixed messages regarding water bottles that have been spoken about outside of school. The rule for water bottles has never changed or been different. Children have access to water bottles as they are stored in one location in each classroom. Children have access to these throughout the day, we just, of course, require children to ask to get out of their seats to get some so that learning in class is not interrupted. Children also have opportunity after every break and lunch time, to get their water bottles. We also provide water for all children in the dining hall at lunch. I am saddened to have seen some unfair emails and comments towards staff saying that the children have been banned from drinking water. This is absolutely not the case and never has been. Alongside this, a reminder that the government guidance for children in schools is as follows: 'Water should be the default drink for every child'. This does mean, that unless there is a medical condition we are aware of, the expectation is that children will be drinking water during the school day.

In the news this week

In Canada, the government in the province Things to talk about at home ... of Ontario is set to pass a new law that will make it compulsory for children aged 12 and under to wear lifejackets on boats. Parents, guardians, or other adults supervising children could be subject to a fine of up to \$200 (£130) if they do not comply. In the UK, currently, there is no legal requirement for anyone using rivers and seas for leisure purposes to wear a lifejacket/personal flotation device (PFD).
