Dear Parents/Carers,

On Wednesday 17th July 2024, Year 1 and Year 4 will be visiting the seaside town of Filey. This visit will provide a memorable enrichment opportunity for the children with the chance to have hands-on experiences that they can then relate their in-class learning to.

There is a cost implication for this visit as the school have to pay for the coach and lunchtime meal. Included in the price is: coach travel to and from Filey; a lunchtime meal from a set menu; and a plethora of enjoyable activities linked to our geography topic – they will also be bringing a stick of rock home with them. The total cost of the trip is £24 per child.

We have taken into consideration the current economic situation and have done all we can to keep the cost of the visit as manageable as possible. Payments can be made in instalments to spread the cost. Of course, if you wish, you may still pay the whole amount. We politely request that payments are made via School Cash Office – this is the case whether you are paying in full or instalments. Please do not send cash into school as we are a cashless setting.

We will be in touch nearer the time with details of the set menu offered and how to order your child's lunch.

There is no obligation to contribute, however I must emphasise that if the level of support is not sufficient to make the visit viable then unfortunately it will not take place for any of the children.

The children will need to be dressed in their school uniform with coats and suitable footwear. We will be leaving school at 8:30am sharp following registration – children can access school from 8am on this day to toilet and register for a sharp departure. We will be leaving Filey at 3pm with the aim of arriving back at school at 16:30pm.
