Dear Parents/Carers,

On Friday 15th December 2023, Year 6 will be visiting the National Coal Mining Museum. This will link with our Science topics: 'Energy' and 'Sustainability'; and Geography topic: 'Globalisation' and 'Industrial Revolution'. This visit will provide a memorable enrichment opportunity for the children with the chance to have hands-on experiences that they can then relate their in-class learning to.

There is a cost implication for this visit as the school have to pay for the coach, admission and workshop. Included in the price is: coach travel to and from the National Coal Mining Museum; Admission and tour of the mine; and a topic-based workshop provided by the museum. The total cost of the trip is £17 per child.

We have taken into consideration the current economic situation and have done all we can to keep the cost of the visit as manageable as possible. Payments can be made in instalments to spread the cost. We politely request that payments are made via School Cash Office – this is the case whether you are paying in full or instalments. Please do not send cash into school as we are a cashless setting.

There is no obligation to contribute the full amount, however I must emphasise that if the level of support is not sufficient to make the visit viable then unfortunately it will not take place for any of the children.

The children will need to be dressed in their school uniform with coats and suitable footwear. A packed lunch will also be required as lunch is not provided by the facility. We will be leaving school at 9am following registration. We will be leaving the museum at 2:30pm with the aim of arriving back at school in time for normal collection.
